

CIO Directory and File Structure

This document sets forth the structure of the CIO web site. While it will list all expected directory names, it will not list all file names.

The following conventions are used herein.

- An italicized name is a temporary directory or file, e.g. *test.html*.
- Items with an asterisk (*) are zipped.
- Items with a plus sign (+) are required by Eclipse, which is the agency approved tool I use to create XSD files for the site – and will continue to need to use if we need to edit the files.
- Asset directories will contain index pages to protect content from inquisitive viewers. They will simply contain a redirect back to the home page.

The following items require resolution as to where we wish to store them. I have them currently located in _Design for convenience in that I can access them from Dreamweaver directly without having to navigate via Windows Explorer.

- _Archives – Contains a copy of the original CSM project plan on which the current plan was based. (Directory created by LaVon Hartman.)
- Documentation_Notes – Design notes, template nomenclature, directory structures notes, etc.
- IA_Schemae – Notes on the IA schemae, versioned by date.
- Mock_Ups – The mock-up files.
- Project_Plans – The project plans for the site development.
